Guidelines for Worship@Home

We are thankful that you can worship@home. Please see the following guidelines for your time of worship:

- 1) Print the liturgy or digitally use it.
- 2) Light a candle and if possible put a Christian object like a Cross on a little table.
- 3) One person should lead. Others can share in reading Scriptures, Psalm and Prayers. (See the attached sheet for readings for 2 weeks)
- 4) Read the Sermon/Homily Reflection aloud. Reflect on it and share if there is any one thing that stands out for you. (Sermons will be send at the latest on Saturday evening with Prayers)
- 5) Pray the Collect provided together as well as the prayer provided for the Corona Virus Pandemic.
- 6) Still offer a collection and Gifts for the Poor. These can be kept together while at home and once you return to Church can be offered.
- 7) If you want to receive spiritual communion... please pray the prayers provided.
- 8) Sing/Play songs or Hymns that may enrich your time together.

We will keep you in our prayers and pray that no harm may come to God's people.

when, with your saints, I may praise you for ever.
Amen
